

MATH 170 - Survey of Calculus

Prerequisite: One of the following:

- Math 105 or an equivalent Transfer Course
- Math Placement Level EXam (MPLEX): Level IV
- College entrance exams:
 - Math ACT score: 25 or higher
 - Math SAT score: 570 or higher

Students will not be allowed to stay in the course without having completed the prerequisite.

TEXT: *Survey of Calculus*, custom MSU edition, by S.T. Tan

There will be two 100 point hour exams and a 200 point final. Calculators are **not** allowed on the exams; however, you can bring an 8x11 note sheet to each exam. It is the student's responsibility to take all exams at the scheduled time. If the student cannot take an exam as scheduled, the student must make arrangements with the course supervisor, Dr. Russ Walker, (rwalker@montana.edu) before the exam date. The usual arrangement for these students will be that the final will count 300 points instead of 200 points. There will also be 100 points based on quizzes and/or homework.
